

# 1. Identification Requirements

## Acceptable forms of Identification for candidates - Original Documents only

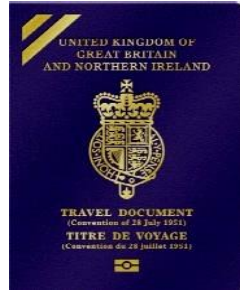
### General ID Document Rules

- All ID documents listed below must contain photos that are **a true likeness of the candidate**.
- The ID document presented on the day of the test and used to validate the candidate must be the **same** document used by the candidate to register and book their Life in the UK Test online.
- Candidates' details displayed on screen must be as stated on the ID provided (and verbally confirmed). This is unless a **UK Marriage Certificate**, valid **UK Spouse Visa** in a Passport (within date) or a **UK Deed Poll** (this must show a red seal) is presented to support this.

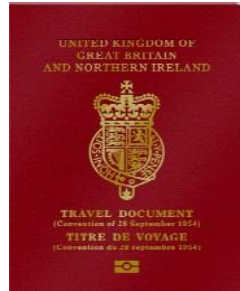
Method of Acceptable ID	
<p><b>A passport from country of origin</b> – this MAY be out of date</p>	
<p><b>A UK (United Kingdom inc NI) photo card driving licence (Full or Provisional)</b> – this MUST be in date</p>	
<p><b>An Immigration Status Document (ISD), endorsed with a UK Residence Permit (UKRP) bearing a photo of the holder</b> - this MAY be out of date</p> <p>- UKRP's are only acceptable when affixed to an Immigration Status Document and not within a Passport.</p> <p>- Candidates in possession of a Passport containing a UKRP should select the 'Passport option'.</p>	



**A Convention travel document (CTD), which is a blue-cover document similar to a UK passport – this MUST be in date**



**A stateless Persons travel document (SPD) this has a red cover similar to a UK passport – this MUST be in date**



**Certificates of Identity (CIDs) – this MUST be in date**



**European Union (EU) Identity Cards – this MUST be in date.**



**Biometric Residence Permit Card – this MUST be in date**  
- BRP's are standalone and not affixed to any other documents.
